

What is a Warrior Buck?

A warrior buck is a physical way to reward students that are seen following the school-wide expectations listed in the matrix for each setting. They are earned when students demonstrate the positive behaviors.

Every week, a Warrior Buck is selected from each homeroom bucket and an incentive is given to those selected students as a way to thank them for displaying positive behaviors.
